**PASSED AWAY, XHELIL PAJAZITI- MEMBER OF
THE CENTRAL ELECTION COMMISSION**

On 7.02. 2010, member of the Central Election Commission, Xhelil Pajaziti passed away, (Ex Representative of PDK in CEC).



Xhelil Pajaziti, was born on 19th of January 1941, in a village of Kamenica Municipality called Poličkë. He was part of the First Teachers Generation of Kosovo (a qualified teacher).Years later, Xhelil Pajaziti started studying Laws, where he graduated in1979. He used to work as teacher until 1980. He got fired from educational process on reason as improper because of his political-ideal views, and got appointed into Agricultural Enterprise of Former-Kamenica Municipality - (Dardana).

After the War in Kosovo, ended on 1999, he was leading Administration Directory in Gjilan and also the Ministry of Public Affairs, of Temporary Government of Kosovo. In First held Local Elections (2000) he was member of Central Election Commission. In 2001 – Parliamentary Elections he was appointed as ECAC member, by OSCE Ambassador.

Since 2002-2005 he was Legal Advisor of the Minister of Public Affairs, Mr. Jakup Krasniqi.

Xhelil Pajaziti was an early political activist before and after ‘90s. He was also cooperator of the illegal newspaper “Zëri i Kosovës” (Voice of Kosovo) which was printed and published in the West by Lëvizja për Republikën e Kosovës. He also wrote many articles regarding political and national situation of Albanian Nation under Former Yugoslavia. After the war, he also wrote into daily newspapers many articles regarding important ongoing processes of Kosovo. Since 2004, he was re-appointed and continued on his role as CEC Member (PDK). The sudden death caught him in the task of Legal Advisor of Parliamentary PDK Group and member of Central Election Commission.
