CHAIRWOMEN NESRIN LUSHTA HAS TAKEN THE POST

The new Chairwomen of Central Election Commission Nesrin Lushta , last Friday has met members of CEC and structures of CECS. After she was welcomed by members of the CEC and other staff of CECS, Lushta held one introducing meeting. Members of the CEC had informed briefly Lushta with main frames of functioning of CEC, the work currently done, and especially with the role of this independent body. Nesrin Lushta, after giving thanks to all, has required that activities, and work in CEC maintains as before, especially now when the country is in eve of the announcement of Local Elections. The President of Republic of Kosovo , Fatmir Sejdiu , appointed on May 14th Nesrin Lushta on top of the Central Election Commission , after the irrevocable resignation of Mr. Zait Xhemajli from this post . Same day, new chairwoman of the CEC gave the oath before President Sejdiu and members of the CEC.

Short biography of The new chairperson of the CEC

Nesrin Lushta graduated in 1982, on Faculty of Law in Prishtina, and has been working as judge in District Court in Mitrovica, since 1992. After that, for nine years she exercised the lawyer job. In 2001, she was appointed as the Director of the Kosovo Judicial Institute. From 2004 until 2006, Nesrin Lushta was a member of Kosovo Judicial and Prosecutorial Council, while she was a consultant and expert for several institutes and international organizations.
