## PRESS RELEASE

Central Election Commission held its 20th meeting headed by President Mrs. Nesrin Lushta. At the beginning of the meeting, the CEC approved the agenda and reports; 06 and 08 / 2010 of held meetings.

Office for Registration of Political Parties informed the CEC that on January 27, political initiative by the Serbian community called "Demokratska Alternativa (DA), lead by Mr. Dragan Stojkovic, has submitted application for registration request as a political party. The Office after receiving the application has checked and verified all the necessary documentation under the conditions for registration. After the period of ten (10) days of verification by the Office, as well as public review of documents dated 11 February to February 17 2010, there are no received complaints or objections regarding the application for registration as political parties of this political initiative.

OPPR, recommended the CEC to register the political initiative, which will enter the 47th place in political party register, registered in Kosovo. Central Election Commission approved this recommendation for registration of this new political entity with the name Alternativa Demokratike (AD).

Also, the Office for Registration of Political Parties recommended to the CEC to take a decision on imposing of administrative fees for political parties which have submitted reports to the Financial Declaration campaign on late term punishable within 15 days. These subjects are: Samostalna LIBERALNA Stranka (SLS), Promene za Gradjanska Initiative (GIZAP), Group Gradjana Kosovski - Bozhur, Zajdno za Siriniçku Zhupu (ZSZH), Narodna Stranka Kosovo, Gani Krasniqi, Predrag Stanojković and the National Front (BK). CEC approved the tariffs that are in the amount of 50, to 500 euros.

Following the meeting, Legal Office recommended the CEC to make replacement of Municipal Assembly Members of Klina Municipal Assembly (1) and Graçanica (1). CEC approved the following changes.

Regarding the organization of the process of revote in the municipality of Gnjilane, the Municipal Electoral Commission (MEC) of the municipality has requested to provide a more efficient solution for ID badges producing which will be used on the day of the Re-poll. Ferid Shabani, chairman of MEC, has presented before the CEC proposals for the design and way of preparation of these badges. CEC in principle gave support to MEC proposal of Gnjilane, but has requested that all technical - legal sides to be realized through the Secretariat of the CEC.
