Registration Party: " Narodna Crnogorska Partija Kosova –**NCPK** " (*Partia Popullore Malaziase e Kosoves*)(Montenegro People's Party of Kosova)- open for public discussion

Prishtina, 31 korrk 2009 - " Partia *Popullore Malaziase e Kosoves*" the acronym NCPK, today has completed the requirements for registration, set forth by the Office for Registration of Political Parties at the Central Election Commission. The final decision for registration of political initiative will be taken after the period of seven (7) days, during which the public can review the registration documents.

"Partia *Popullore Malaziase e Kosoves* " was established on 20 May 2009 by Mr. Lazar Radulloviq. Its residence is located in Çaglavica. Under this program they will be committed to equality of all citizens, to protect and ensure the rights of displacers, return to their homes and commitment to acceptance and incorporation of malaziasve (Montenegro entity) into the Constitution of Kosova. " Partia *Popullore Malaziase e Kosoves* " will engage in the democratic environment to realize its program and goals for participation and benefit of voters in elections. Will engage the democratization of social life, tolerance, equality and freedom for citizens, for the preservation of national identity, religion, culture, and language and healthprotection of citizens.

Office for Registration of Political Parties has been given responsibility for registering political parties in Kosova, the Law on General Elections in the Republic of Kosova nr.03/L-073.

According to the CEC Rule nr.01/2008 for "Registration and Operation of Political Parties in Kosova" Anyone can object the request on the basis of one or more reasons set forth in Section 5 with the submission of written objections to the Office together with any information or material that supports objections within seven (7) days from announcement of the request.

All registration materials including party program, statute, and the sign will be available for view and comments from the public. Promoting transparency to the process of registration of political parties is part of the CEC.
